

Egg Freezing at Demeter

Before commencing a freeze cycle you will have had a consultation with one of our doctors to discuss your options and devise a treatment plan. When you are comfortable with the plan and costs associated you can call our admin or monitoring team to update that you would like to proceed.

Our monitoring team will organise for you to attend a session to discuss your treatment plan in detail and learn how to use your medications. Once you are prepared, your treatment cycle will look like this:



Call Day One

Call our admin team on the first day of your menstrual cycle. If this is over the weekend, call us first thing Monday.

Our monitoring team will be advised and contact you to discuss your next step including signing your treatment consent.



Blood Tests & Ultrasound

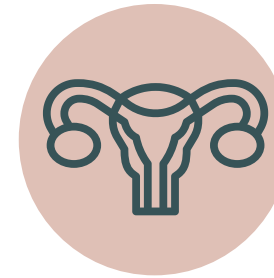
Begin your medication injections as advised by the support team and attend any blood tests or ultrasounds.

These will be booked with our monitoring team or organised externally for you!



Medications & Trigger

When your follicles have reached desired parameters (based on your ultrasounds), the monitoring team will advise you when to take your trigger medication. It is important you follow this instruction closely.



Collect & Freeze

Your collection will be booked approximately 36hrs after your trigger time. Payment for your cycle is due prior to this.

Attend the collection location for your procedure.

An Embryologist will be there to take your eggs back to the lab to freeze!
