- Fertilisation of donor oocytes and freeze of any suitable embryos - from **\$2900** (Medicare rebate available)
- Frozen embryo transfer - from **\$4000 per treatment cycle** (Medicare rebate available)
- Genetic testing - **\$900**, genetic counselling included at no additional cost
- Counselling - **\$340**

FAQ's

What is the waiting period for obtaining a donor egg or sperm?

There are typically no waiting periods except for shipping, which can take approximately 1-3 weeks. The longest wait usually results from the decision patients have to make when selecting a donor.

What is the estimated cost of this process?

Everyone's treatment requirements differ, depending on the chosen path. The prices (AUD) below provide insight into what to expect, **all costs are approximate and vary depending on individual treatment approaches and are subject to change.** Speak directly to our team for your individual costs.

- Initial consultation: \$500 (Medicare rebate available)
- Follow-up consultation: \$375
- Counselling: \$340
- Genetic testing: \$900
- ICSI: approx. \$11,405 (Medicare rebate available)

Do you have alternative payment options?

Is it possible to purchase embryos?

Unfortunately, you are unable to purchase embryos through us but you can purchase donor eggs and donor sperm separately and have the embryos created in our lab.

FAQ's

What types of genetic testing can be done to ensure that I am receiving the correct egg or sperm?

Most donor companies we work with have already done testing, using renowned companies like Invitae or Myriad. Speak to our Donor Coordinator for further information.

Can I take purchased gametes elsewhere?

No. At Demeter we have worked hard to build one of the largest list of donors in Australia and we take pride in these exclusive opportunities, so any gametes you purchase through our contracts must be used for cycles with Demeter.

Do these companies provide a guarantee?

Most banks we work with offer a 1 blastocyst out of 6 oocytes purchased guarantee. This means that if you buy 6 oocytes, the donor company guarantees that at least one of them will develop into a blastocyst ready for transfer. Each bank will have different specification so it's important to check these when you purchase eggs and guarantees.

Do we offer services to same-sex male couples?
